Carson City is served by one Central Office which is connected via two diverse redundant paths to the Reno/Sparks area to ensure network reliability and disaster recovery.

The Carson City Central Office houses both a Nortel DMS switch and an Avaya 5ESS switch, providing a choice of serving arrangements for large customers.

Companies located in Carson City, such as Harley Davidson, have access to a variety of products and services including T1(1.5Mbps), DS3 (45Mbps) ATM (Asynchronous Transfer Mode), Centrex, Flat Rate Business lines, PBX trunks, PRI (Primary Rate ISDN), Frame Relay, SONET, GigaMAN (point to point gigabit Ethernet), Business telephone systems, Network Integration services and DSL.

SBC/Nevada Bell has 90% coverage for DSL within Carson's city limits, and DSL Internet Services are now available to approximately 170,000 homes and businesses in Nevada.
