### Trucking

I-80 passes through the southeast corner of Humboldt County, connecting Reno/Sparks and Salt Lake City. U.S. Highway 95 bisects the county, passing north-south through Winnemucca.

I-80 traversed the northern end of Lander County east-west, passing through Battle Mountain. State Highway 305 north-south bisects the county, linking Battle Mountain and Austin. Highway 50 runs east-west at the county's southern end, passing through Austin.

### Foreign Trade Zones

Northern Nevada has nearly 7,500 acres of Foreign Trade Zones. A Foreign Trade Zone is designated by the United States Customs Department and allows foreign and domestic merchandise to be admitted for operations such as storage, exhibition, assembly, manufacture, and processing, without being subject to formal Customs entry procedures, the payment of Customs duties or the payment of federal excise taxes.

### Rail Service

Passenger service is provided by Amtrak. Freight service is provided by Union Pacific and Burlington Northern Santa Fe railroads.

### Bus Service

Greyhound Bus Lines offers bus service to northwestern Nevada.

### Airport

**Winnemucca Municipal Airport** is located 5 miles southwest of Winnemucca. There are two lighted runways, one 5,000 feet long and the other is 7,000 ft., and one fixed-based operator.

**Battle Mountain/Lander County Airport** is located 2 1/2 miles southeast of Battle Mountain. It has two lighted runways, both are 7,300 feet, asphalt. There are also two helipads, each measuring 60X60 feet. Charter service is offered through Lander Aviation.

**Austin Airport** is located 10 miles west of town includes a lighted 6,000 foot runway.

**Derby Field** is located 7 miles south of Lovelock, Nevada, this airport has a 5,530 paved runway.
